







Medical cases per risk category in 2013







Risk of medical evacuation is highest in countries with high and extreme medical risk




Medical cases per risk category








Medical cases in 2013 per region and medical country risk category








2013: die Top 10 med. Diagnosen (ICD 9)










- 53 "GAN" staffs in 29 Alarm Centers including 4 regional "GAN" managers in Asia, Europe, Americas and Australia

- The assessment and the ranking of providers result from regular Site Audits, formal credentialing and from an on-going monitoring of case managements feedbacks


